- When purchasing new equipment or plant, take into consideration environmental performance capabilities, selecting items which best meet the needs of the environments it is working in.
- Wherever possible, use non-toxic or green cleaning methodologies to ensure the health and wellbeing of our staff and the people and environments surrounding the sites as which we are working.
- Provide appropriate training and equipment to staff who may be required to use hazardous substances, including the creation of SWMS, JSAs and the provision of SDS for all chemicals being made available on all sites at all times.
- Ensure that staff are aware of correct disposal of any hazardous substances which could be used as a part of the provision of our services.



To be a responsible and transparent business, Associated Cleaning Services will:

- Embed sustainability as a principle into the business, so all employees have a clear and shared understanding about what it means and how they can apply it.
- Commit to learning more about sustainability and keep our approach current so we can play our role as a leader for our industry.
- Acknowledge that sustainability is a complex and multifaceted challenge, and not simply the
 effective management of environmental resources.
- Ensure our decisions have equal consideration of social, economic and environmental issues and are informed by the best available evidence and understanding of global, national, state and regional issue
